The Summer Math is an online program called iknowit.com. Your child's log-in information was sent home in May. We have assigned sections that must be completed, but after those sections are completed your child may work on any other section for enrichment. This assignment must be completed by Monday, August 6. Teachers will check for completion of assignments on the website after Monday, August 6. The assignments will not be posted until Friday, May 25.

Please do not begin Summer Math until Friday, May 25

The Summer Reading is to read at least six books and record on the Reading Log (attached to this sheet) the books. This reading log will be turned in the first day of school.

The Summer Reading and Math will count as a tests grade.

Religion: If you are Catholic, we will need a copy of your child's baptismal certificate. Catholic, second grade students will make their First Reconciliation and Holy Communion, and they must have been baptized to receive these Sacraments. If you are Catholic and your child has not been baptized, please contact the church office this summer for guidance.
