Basic Catechism

Confession

Four things are required of a repentant in order to receive the sacrament of confession worthily:

- 1. Make a good examination of conscience.
- 2. Have a contrite heart. In other words, be sorry for your sins.
- 3. Confess those sins fully, in kind and in number. (What are they and how many times?)
- 4. Do the penance and make amends.

The Precepts of the Catholic Church

What makes you a good catholic? To be a Catholic you need to keep the five precepts of the church. They are:

- 1. "You shall attend Mass on Sundays and on holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor."
- 2. "You shall confess your sins at least once a year."
- 3. "You shall receive the Sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season."
- 4. "You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church."
- 5. "You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church. (Financially and being volunteers)"

3 Dispositions to Receive Holy Communion

- 1. Being in a State of Grace
- 2. Fasting for One Hour.
- 3. Devotion and attention

The 10 Commandments

- 1. I, the Lord, am your God. You shall not have other gods besides me.
- 2. You shall not take the name of the Lord God in vain
- Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day
- 4. Honor your father and your mother
- 5. You shall not kill
- 6. You shall not commit adultery
- 7. You shall not steal
- 8. You shall not bear false witness
- 9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife
- You shall not covet your neighbor's goods
