After reading a book, record the book on the “Summer Reading Log” form, and turn it in on the first day of school. This will count as the first Reading test grade.

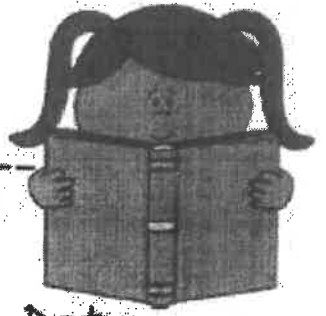
