Requirements:

All **fifth graders at SLS** are required to earn 5 total service hours toward Religion requirements.

At least 2 of those hours must be performed in St. Louis Parish.

At least half (2.5) of the student's total hours must be completed by December 2, 2022. Remaining hours must be completed by May 5, 2023.

All **sixth graders at SLS** are required to earn 10 total service hours toward Religion requirements.

At least 3 of those hours must be performed in St. Louis Parish.

At least half (5) of the student's total hours must be completed by December 2, 2022. Remaining hours must be completed by May 5, 2023.

All **seventh graders at SLS** are required to earn 15 total service hours towards Religion requirements.

At least 5 of those hours must be performed in St. Louis Parish.

At least half (7.5) of the student's total hours must be completed by December 2, 2022. Remaining hours must be completed by May 5, 2023.

All **eighth graders at SLS** are required to earn 20 total service hours towards Religion requirements and Confirmation prep.

At least 7 of those hours must be performed in St. Louis Parish.

At least half (10) of the student's total hours must be completed by December 2, 2022.

Remaining hours must be completed by April 14, 2023.

All **Confirmandi from St. Agnes Academy/St. Dominic School** are required to earn 5 total service hours towards Confirmation prep.

All 5 of those hours must be performed in St. Louis Parish.

All hours must be completed by April 14, 2023.

These hours should be earned specifically towards Confirmation prep and should be in addition to any SAA-SDS service requirements.

All **Confirmandi in the St. Louis Church PRE Program** are required to earn 20 total hours toward Confirmation prep.

At least 7 of those hours must be performed in St. Louis Parish.

All hours must be completed by April 14, 2023.

Parish hours are hours performed in St. Louis Parish/School that benefit the parish/school. **Community hours** are hours that benefit the greater community.

- All hours must be approved in advance by the student's Religion teacher unless the hours are on the pre-approved list.
- Individual students must get personal pre-approval from his/her Religion teacher. Just because a peer got approval does not mean it has been approved for you.
- All signatures must be from the approving agency. Parent signatures are not accepted.
- Signatures should be obtained as the hours are performed. If this is not possible, students will have one month after the service date to obtain the signatures.
- All signatures should be on this form.
- "Bonus" hours cannot be earned. You can only earn service hours for actual hours served.
- All hours completed between May 29, 2022-September 2, 2022 must be turned in by September 2, 2022.
- All hours completed in the Fall semester must be turned in by December 2, 2022.
- Students may begin performing service hours for the 2022-2023 school year on May 27, 2022.

Service Hours Information

Rising 5th-8th graders at SLS and candidates for Confirmation may begin performing his/her 2022/2023 service hours on May 28, 2022. A list of pre-approved service suggestions (both community and parish) follows. A student may choose to conduct all service hours in the parish. If you wish to perform a service not on this list please check with your Religion teacher for approval before performing the service. **ALL SERVICE HOURS NOT ALREADY ON THE PRE-APPROVED LIST MUST BE APPROVED. ANY HOURS NOT PRE-APPROVED WILL NOT BE COUNTED.**

NEW TO SLS...Our school will begin implementing the x2VOL online program this year as a means to track and verify all service hour opportunities for students. Information on how to login to your student account and how to enter your service hours will be emailed to you and your parents. We will slowly eliminate all paper forms, but this summer, a service hour form or x2VOL verified submission will be accepted.

Your teacher will provide you with the appropriate form. This form requires a signature from someone at the agency or organization where you provided service to confirm your hours. Parent signatures are never accepted. Signatures should be obtained as the hours are performed. **If this is not possible, students will have one month after the service was performed to obtain the appropriate signature.**

The service hour form will be turned in to your Religion/Confirmation class teacher. Due dates are listed on the back of the service hours form.

2022-2023 Requirements

- St. Louis School 5th Grade: 5 total hours (2 of which must be parish hours)
- St. Louis School 6th Grade: 10 total hours (3 of which must be parish hours)
- St. Louis School 7th Grade: 15 total hours (5 of which must be parish hours)
- St. Louis School 8th Grade: 20 total hours (7 of which must be parish hours)
- St. Agnes-St. Dominic Confirmandi: 5 parish hours
- St. Louis Church PRE Confirmandi: 20 total hours (7 of which must be parish hours)



Determining Your Service

In determining your community service, try to find opportunities that directly serve the poor or those in true need of service. Service hours are unpaid hours. Pre-approved opportunities are listed below.

Pre-Approved Community Service

- Catholic HEART Workcamp
- Altar server at another parish
- Room In the Inn
- St. Mary's Soup Kitchen (*If making sandwiches, the student must make 50 sandwiches on his/her own to earn one hour. Time is not given for shopping or driving to deliver.*)

These are certainly not the only hours you can perform. If you have other ideas for service hours, contact your Religion/Confirmation teacher. **All hours MUST be pre-approved.**

Students do not receive service hours for working fundraisers that benefit them. For example, working a fundraiser is not service if you are raising money for a mission trip.



Babysitting and yardwork are typically not approved for service hours. Contact your teacher for specific situations where this might count.

Students should also not combine Religion/Confirmation service hours with service hours for other organizations (i.e. Beta Club, National Junior Honor Society, scouts, cheerleading, SAA-SDS requirements, etc.).

Youth cannot earn service hours during the school day.
