Summer Math uses the program IXL.com, which can be completed on an ipad, chromebook, or computer. Rising 2nd graders should only work in the FIRST GRADE SECTION. IXL work must be completed from May 31st – August 9th. If your child has already completed the section on IXL during the school year, he/she must redo the section to reflect that it was completed during the summer. In second grade, we consider mastery of a skill at 90%. This assignment will be a Math test grade. Please encourage your child to work on more sections than required, especially the basic math facts sections!

We have included both the IXL numbers and the titles of the selections. Sometimes over the summer the IXL program changes the numbers of certain titles. If that happens, please complete the section by title! You may have to do a little hunting to find it.

Our school has a special account for ixl.com. PLEASE make sure you use the username@saintlouis (the username is your child's first initial, middle initial and last name) and the password is your child's birthday in digits (no year, for example – 0323 for March 23).
