Rising 2nd Grade Students St. Louis School Summer Math 2025

Summer Math uses the program IXL.com, which can be completed on an ipad, chromebook, or computer. Rising 2nd graders should only work in the FIRST GRADE SECTION. IXL work must be completed from June 1st – August 4th. If your child has already completed the section on IXL during the school year, he/she must redo the section to reflect that it was completed during the summer. In second grade, we consider mastery of a skill at 90%. This assignment will be a Math test grade. Please encourage your child to work on more sections than required but only in the first grade section.

We have included the IXL numbers, the titles of the selections and the search code. Sometimes over the summer the IXL program changes the numbers of certain titles. If that happens, please complete the section by title or search code. You may have to do a little hunting to find it.

Your child will login to IXL through their clever account.

**** Please work with your children on memorizing Addition and Subtraction facts within 20 (2+4, 11-5, etc). It is very important that they have these facts memorized!
